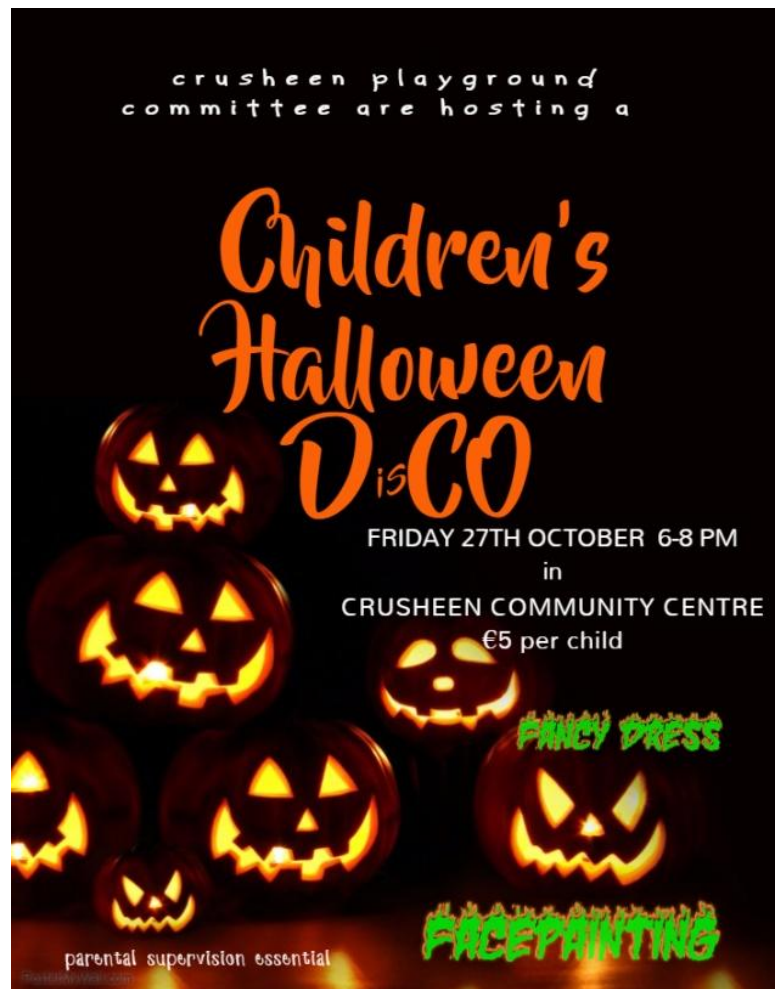


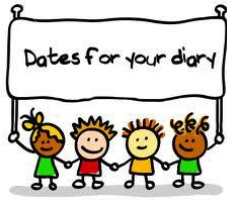
WhatsApp Group for Parents.
