Headlice

There is a case of headlice in the school. Please check your child's hair daily for headlice in case your child may have been exposed. Your family doctor or chemist will be able to answer any further questions that you might have concerning head lice and the available lotions and shampoos.

Hand Foot & Mouth

We have been informed Health Service Executive to notify all parents that there has been an outbreak of Hand, Foot and mouth disease in the area. Generally, hand, foot and mouth disease is a mild and short-lasting illness. Treatment is usually not needed as the body's immune system clears the virus and symptoms go away after about 7 to 10 days. Please read the letter given to your child today.

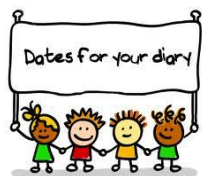
