Table Quiz – St. Tolas

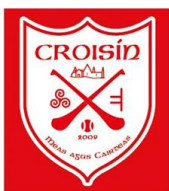

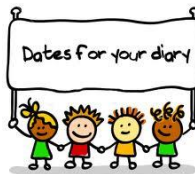
Croisín Calendar for sale
