If you are a parent of a pupil/pupils, who is/are already attending Tulla Secondary school or you have child/children who hope to attend next year or in the coming years, and wish to express an interest in the service, please follow the following procedure:

- 1. Log onto the Bus Éireann website.
- 2. Press the Menu logo on the left.
- 3. Click the option for Customer Information, then select Customer Care.
- 4. Fill in the enquiry form, give as much information as possible.
- 5. You will be given a case number and then you can email your case number to schools.limerick@buseireann.ie stating why you and other parents require this service,

due to concerns with lack of secondary school places in Ennis, etc.
